

Scrubbies and Soap Saver

Skills:

- chain (ch)
- single crochet (sc)
- half double crochet (hdc)
- double crochet (dc)
- slip stitch (slst)
- magic ring (mr)

Materials needed

- cotton yarn in cream (A), brown (B) and red ©
- G hook with A ch 16
- darning needle

with A ch 16

Rnd 1: hdc in third chain from hook, hdc in remaining 13 st, don't turn your work but continue with a hdc in underside of ch and continue with 13 hdc, your beginning ch 2 counts as a hdc so make a slst in the top of ch 2

Rnd 2-14: hdc around (28) and count your ch 2 as a hdc this will ensure your seam stays on the side of the soap saver.

Rnd 15: ch 3, dc around, slst in top of 3rd chain

Rnd 16: ch 1, sc around

fasten off and weave in ends

with B ch 50 starting with a long tail and fasten off leaving a long tail, weave into Rnd 15 of saver, knot tails together folding it over twice to make a tassel, cut the ends open

Rose

with C ch 13

Row 1: *sc, 2sc around

Row 2: ch 2, *hdc, 2hdc around

fasten off leaving a tail to sew the rose onto the soap saver (neatly. as you will be able to see inside!)



Scrubby (make 3 or 4)

with A start a mr

always ch 2 at the beginning of Rnd 2 - 4

Rnd 1: sc 8 into ring

Rnd 2: hdc2 around

Rnd 3: *hdc, 2 hdc around

Rnd 4: *2hdc, hdc 2 around, hdc in same st as starting
fasten off, weave in ends

with B slst into first hdc of Rnd 4

ch 21 and end in same hdc with a slst, making a loop
fasten off and weave in ends
