

Rainbow Nesting Bowls

Pattern by Andrea at Crochet Therapy



These colorful Waldorf bowls are designed to promote spatial awareness. Little ones are attracted to their bright colors and will stack and nest them for hours!

Materials

Worsted weight yarn in five rainbow colors

(I used Red Heart Super Saver Acrylic yarn in rainbow colors, but will use cotton yarn to make them for my baby)

3.75 mm hook

Yarn needle

Skill

Magic ring (mr)

Single Crochet (Sc)

Sc in back loop (BL)

Slip Stitch (slst)

Instructions

Stagger your increases following the pattern so you don't end up with an octagon shaped bottom, While crocheting the bottom and BL only round join rounds with a slst and ch 1. Then use a stitch marker and **do not** join, but crochet around until you start the final (slst) round!



Bowl 1 (blue)

Make a mr

Rnd 1: 8 sc into mr

Rnd 2: 2sc around (16)

Rnd 3: *sc, 2c around (24)

Rnd 4: *2sc, sc in next 2 st, around (32)

Rnd 5: sc in next 2 st, *2sc, sc in next 3, around, sc in last (40)

Rnd 6: sc, *2sc, sc in next 4, around, sc in last 3 (48)

Rnd 7: sc around

Rnd 8: in BLs only sc around

Rnd 9 - 17: sc around

Rnd 18: slst around

Fasten off, weave in ends

Bowl 2 (red)

Make mr

Repeat Rnds 1 - 6 from bowl 1 (48)

Rnd 7: in BLs only sc around

Rnd 8 - 13 sc around

Rnd 14: slst around

Fasten off, weave in ends

Bowl 3 (orange)

Make mr

Repeat Rnds 1 - 5 from bowl 1 (40)

Rnd 6: in BLs only sc around

Rnd 7 - 12: sc around

Rnd 13: slst around

Fasten off, weave in ends

Bowl 4 (yellow)

Make mr

Repeat Rnds 1 - 4 from bowl 1 (32)

Rnd 5: in BLs only sc around

Rnd 6 - 9: sc around

Rnd 10: slst around

Fasten off, weave in ends

Bowl 5 (green)

Make mr

Repeat Rnd 1 - 3 from bowl 1 (24)

Rnd 4: sc around

Rnd 5: in BL only sc around

Rnd 6 - 8: sc around

Rnd 9: slst around

Fasten off, weave in ends
